Our Process

Traditionally Malbec has been used for blending in other wines. Its contribution would be to add fruitiness, round out the mouthfeel, and mellow the wine. By itself, Malbec is a very drinkable wine. It is medium-bodied, mellow and fruity with very soft finegrained tannins. Wooden Valley's Malbec has all of these attributes, very drinkable and a customer favorite.

Fun fact...Malbec is one of the 5 Bordeaux varietals. The red wines of Bordeaux are usually blends of two or more of the five popular grapes which include: Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc, Petit

Tasting Notes

Black cherries and plums join with notes of violets and vanilla on the nose. On the palate, the wine is rich and full-bodied with flavors of juicy blackberries, cranberries, and black currants.
