Our Process

To honor our Italian heritage, we planted Barbera in 2012. Known for its adaptability to a wide range of vineyard soils, Barbera thrives in our rich Suisun Valley terroir. Barbera is native to the Piedmont region of Northern Italy, which is where the Lanza family originates. This red Italian wine grape produces good yields and is known for its deep color, full-body, low tannins, and high levels of acid. This Italian-style wine should be enjoyed relatively young. Its juicy, rich, full-bodied profile and soft tannins make it incredibly smooth and approachable.

Tasting Notes

Toasty, fruity aromas, and flavors of cherry, raspberries, and rich, ripe plums dominate this fruity and juicy Barbera. It has a satiny, fruity, medium-full body and a complex, long finish — a great approach to this classic Italian variety that features lots of fruit and chocolatey oak flavors.
