#### **Our Process**

The Lanza Family brand is about taking wine to the next level. Using a combination of time-honored traditions handed down through three generations, we have crafted a lovely wine.

Brand

Suisun Valley offers the ideal climate and soil combination to grow outstanding Petite Sirah.

At Lanza Vineyards, we are fortunate to have the luxury of choice. We choose the best grapes from multiple vineyard sources for each vintage of Lanza Family wine. Our Vineyard Managers, Larry and Ken Lanza keep a very close eye on the vineyards all year. Early in the growing season, they choose the best grape blocks and designate them for the Lanza Family program. Once the decision is made, the selected vines are closely watched and meticulously managed. We make multiple thinning passes to adjust and manage crop size. When shoot thinning, we only leave one cane per spur when typically we would leave two. Finally, these wines spend an extended period barrel and bottle aging to allow them to develop into the wine you're enjoying today.

Fun Fact: Did you know Petite Sirah first came to America in the mid-1880s? We are happy it did because our very own Suisun Valley takes great pride in its Petites. Not only are they a popular varietal, but many of our vintages have been award winners!

## **Tasting Notes**

This 2019 is a fast favorite with raisin, blackberry, and vanilla on the nose. The dark, beautiful, rich color reflects the full flavors of black cherry, slight pepper, and soft plum.
