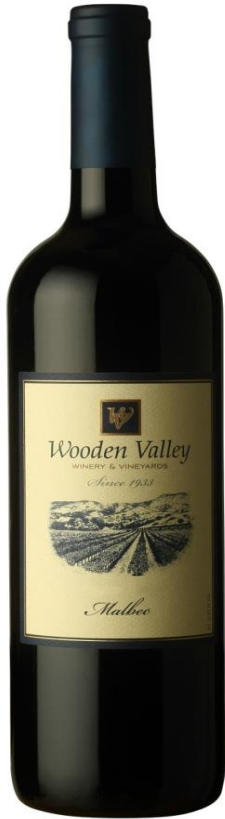

Our Process

Traditionally Malbec is used for blending in other wines. Its contribution would be to add fruitiness, round out the mouthfeel, and mellow the wine. By itself, Malbec is a very drinkable wine. It is medium-bodied, mellow, and fruity with very soft, fine-grained tannins. Wooden Valley's Malbec has all of this attributes-very drinkable and a customer favorite.

Fun fact...Malbec is one of the 5 Bordeaux varietals. The red wines of Bordeaux are usually blends of two or more of the five popular grapes, which include: Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc, Petit Verdot, and Malbec.

Tasting Notes

Incredibly approachable with a delicate mouthfeel and subtle tannins, our 2019 Malbec has a bold nose of lush raspberry and blueberry with warm clove and a hint of violet. Enjoy the flavors of freshly picked plum followed by savory blackcurrant with a variety of grilled meats such as sausage, burnt pork ends, and seasoned ribs.

It's interesting to note that Argentina produces 75% of the world's Malbec.
