Our Process

Traditionally Malbec has been used for blending; its contribution is adding fruitiness, rounding out the mouthfeel, and mellowing the wine. However, by itself, Malbec is a very drinkable wine. It is mediumbodied, mellow, and fruity with very soft, finegrained tannins. Wooden Valley's Malbec has all these attributes and more—A very drinkable customer favorite.

Fun fact...Malbec is one of the five designated Bordeaux varietals. The red wines of Bordeaux are traditionally blends of two or more of five popular grapes, which include: Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc, Petit Verdot, and Malbec.

Tasting Notes

Malbec is mainly grown in Argentina, accounting for 75% of planted acres worldwide. However, it is an extremely popular wine here at Wooden Valley Winery. With its soft tannins and low acid, our Malbec has aromas of raisin, crushed violets, fresh-picked blueberries, and a slight earthiness. The light and smooth flavors of plum and slightly bitter chocolate make the Malbec a great wine to pair with rich meat dishes.
